

MCNS SPORT - MCC REPRESENTATION

Marist competes against seven other schools in the MCC Competition. MCC was established in 1922. This competition takes place on Thursday afternoons between 1.00pm and 4.30pm depending on sport. One Day events are between 9am - 3.30pm on selected Thursdays.

Year 7 Students are not eligible for MCC sport in the first seven weeks at the College.

Selection for the other sports is by trials.</p> <p>For those teams and ages MCC will choose representative teams to participate in the NSW CCC Championships. Further representation is then available dependant on selection.</p> <p>There are a number of other sports e.g Cricket, Basketball, where further representation and selection is available. Boys need to be nominated individually by parents through the NSWCCC Website and the school will approve that nomination once the process is completed by parents. CCC controls the selection of these teams. CCC then communicate directly with the successful representatives in regard to venues, times and costs.</p>
