Dear Parents and Guardians,

I welcome you all back to school for Term 3 on Monday. Undoubtedly, you would have been following the media coverage of areas of COVID outbreaks in both Sydney and Victoria.

Just a reminder that if you have traveled to Victoria during the holiday break or have been at any of the listed Sydney areas at the relevant times (see [NSW Health information](#)) NSW Health have directed that you isolate for 14 days from your return even if you have returned a negative COVID test.

If you are unsure if you are required to isolate, please contact the local public health unit for guidance. If you are isolating or have been affected, please reach out to the College confidentially to discuss the situation and know that we will support you.

Attendance remains compulsory for all students unless they are unwell. The usual procedures around absences must be followed. If your son is unwell, please contact the College via the Compass app and for prolonged absences, a doctor's certificate must be provided that clearly explains the absence. This is particularly important for students in Year 12, who must follow all NESA guidelines with regards to absences.

Marist College continues to be hyper-vigilant about hygiene and cleanliness and we will continue undertaking all measures to ensure the health and safety of our community. We ask for your support in this by not sending your son/s to school if they are unwell.

As school returns, we have been advised to continue to restrict adults on site to those only deemed essential. Excursions at this stage are still not permitted to go ahead however, Thursday sport will resume for all students. Trials for MCC will begin in Week 1 and the competition will start in Week 2. Please note, the boys will resume normal school hours on a Thursday and will not be dismissed until 2:10pm.

If you have any concerns regarding your son/s, please contact his Tutor or House Coordinator.

We look forward to welcoming all staff and students back to school on Monday.
