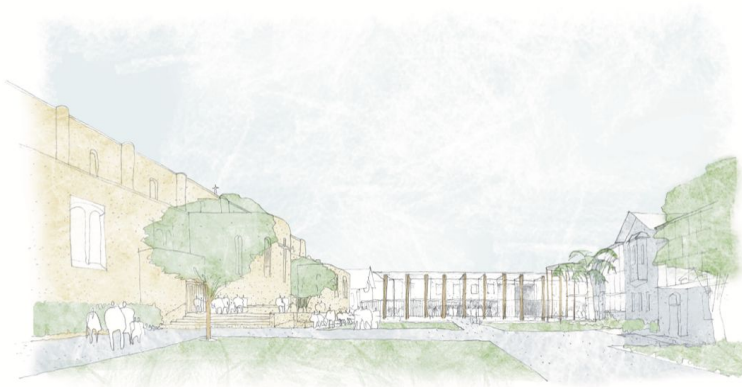


NORTH SHORE

Coeducation in the heart of North Sydney*

A great deal of work is being undertaken at the precinct level in preparation for the transition from St Mary's Catholic Primary School and Marist College North Shore to become one K-12 coeducational school, Marist Catholic College North Shore in 2021. As part of that preparation, new uniforms, a new crest, and Mission Statement are being prepared. As well as this important work a comprehensive masterplan for the North Sydney Catholic Education precinct is being developed. This masterplan will unite the parish and educational communities in a single location. The masterplan, to be delivered over 10 years, will include new state of the art learning spaces, a multi-purpose performance space, indoor/outdoor cafe, and canteen and new leafy and practical recreation spaces. There will be a seamless connection between the school campuses supporting students from Early Learning through Kindergarten to Year 12. An open space piazza, connecting the heritage church to the overall precinct will be accessible to parishioners, the school and at times the local community.

The building works for the educational component of the masterplan has begun with Stage 1 modifications to the high school campus to support the transition towards coeducation in 2021. The proposed masterplan will be staged to support the growth in student numbers across the K-12 school whilst managing impact through construction.

There will be a series of consultation opportunities regarding the masterplan made available to the school community commencing in August. The details of these consultations will be sent to parents in advance. We look forward to your feedback.
